Exit 31, Take Route 49 to Rome to 46 N. to 26 'N.

Exit 32, Take Route 233 to 46 N. to 26 N.

Exit 33, Take Route 365 to 46 N. to 26 N.

(Exits are 15 minutes from Rome)

Details: Turin Road:

"The Beeches" is just off NYS Route 26.

As you go north on Route 26 you will pass the old high school building on the right, with a football stadium immediately after the school building. After the stadium there is a signal at Jervis Avenue, and another one at Chestnut street. After that Gillette's Big M Market is on the right. Next comes Anken's farm (and large red barn). Then there is a driveway with the Beeches sign. Either go in there for the rear entrance, or go to Potter road at the top of the hill and turn right, then the first driveway on the right is the front entrance.
